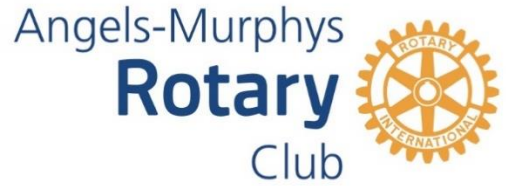

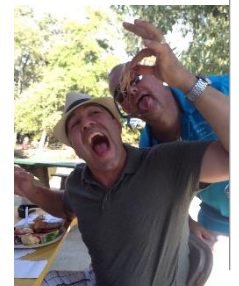
CURRENT PROJECTS:

In the last two weeks we've had several prospective member join us as well as valuable guest presentations. Steve Shetzline, Executive Director of the Murphys Senior Center shared many interesting developments at his organization. There has been an influx of 50-60 year olds at the center's activities as more folks retire to our community. They opened a second thrift store on Tom Bell Rd. and they ask that we keep bringing good donations ... the stores are their major source of funding. Mark Twain Hospital is now providing the Tuesday lunches at the center and a quarter of the people they are feeding via their food pantry are under 18 years old. New activities include tai chi, fall prevention and strength training classes. They are open Mon-Fri, check out their website for the calendar of activities. Steve would like to encourage more men to join in. He is very appreciative of our club's financial support and the positive impact Rotary has made on his family and in our community.

Last week's speakers were John Osbourn and Chad Cossey from the Office of Emergency Services. They did a nice overview of OES, discussing their roles as well how county, state and federal services coordinate during an emergency. The impending PG&E power outages and generator usage were also hot topics. We hope to have them back this winter to teach us more.
