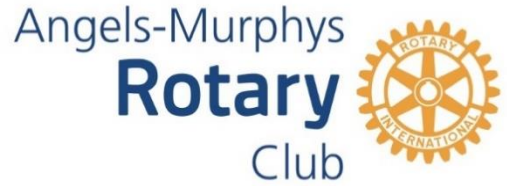

Last week we welcomed Rotarian Roger Huddlestone, transferring from the Arnold club, and Debbie’s guest Judy from the Community Club Board. Homecoming, complete with duck races in the creek was held Saturday in the park, with our own Louie flipping burgers.



President Scott presented Steve Shetzline, ED of the Murphys Senior Center, with our donation of \$1500 that supports their meal programs. We’ve been supporting them annually for 12 years. Steve explained that the center is reopened, with new classes (line dancing, anyone?) and a free food pantry for anyone in need. During the shutdown, they delivered thousands of meals to our homebound residents.

Speaker Kopavi Bluestar is a true local who is now raising six children here. With tourism growing in our beautiful area, she noticed an increase in trash being left in our natural areas and towns. She started a Facebook group to find others who would like to join in, and in no time had 200 people to form the Calaveras Highway 4 Clean-Up Crew! Now 1000 strong, they have held clean up events yielding mattresses, appliances, and all sorts of junk. They now need help forming a non-profit. We passed the hat and donated \$227 to the effort.
