We heard about air raids, darkened windows, and her father's and uncle's participation in the resistance. They hid 10 people in their house and were finally invaded by the Gestapo who took her father and all their belongings. They survived for two more years with little to no food, water, soap or clothing. Irene is an inspiration to listen to and shares her lessons learned ~ never, ever give up, keep fighting fascism, and keep your sense of humor.
