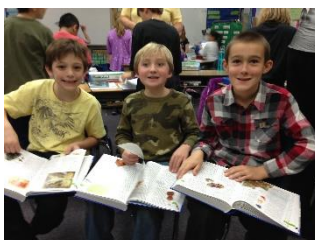

We continue with our tradition of giving beautifully illustrated children's dictionaries to all 3rd grade students in our area. This includes almost 150 kids at Mark Twain,

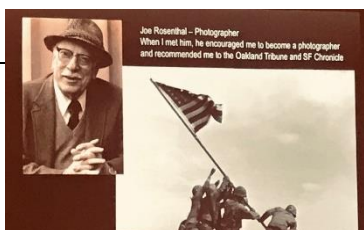
Michelson and Copperopolis elementary schools. We still see the joy it brings to look up words and share with friends using a real book!

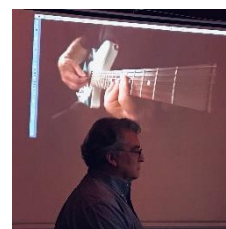
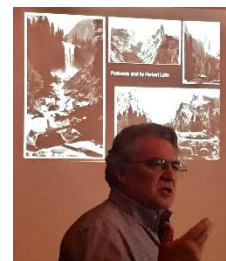
## In case you missed it . . .

Last week it was great to see Bob Henkel back. Prez Steve shared some club history, noting that three of the first women to join Rotary in the 1987-89 era were in **our club** following the US Supreme Court case that opened the doors. One of them was recent speaker and historian, Maureen Elliott. Our own Liz Millier also joined in 1989.



Our esteemed guest Jeffrey Luhn shared a most interesting history of his career in photography. He took us through the early days with his family shop on Kearney

St. in SF and being mentored by Joe Rosenthal (who took the famous Iwo Jima picture). Jeff started out traveling through Europe, taking portraits and documenting the spread of hippie culture. Back in the Bay Area, he set up the D.A.'s crime photography department where he analyzed Patty Hearst's security cam images. Jeff then traveled the world documenting conflicts in Mexico, Sri Lanka, Vietnam, the Philippines and has lived to tell us these fascinating and scary stories! Jeff still works in Sonora and his advice is to print out your family photos and write on the back so future generations will remember. *Steve wasn't able to fish out the black marble... super pot rolls up to \$450.*
