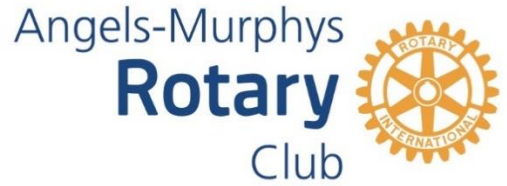

Ben have re-launched The Metropolitan, an entertainment venue in San Andreas. Originally a hotel, the "Met" was built at the base of Main Street in 1859. A fire consumed the building in 1926, and in its place a movie theater was built in the 1950s. It was later renovated as a dining hall and performance venue. Now it's open as a restaurant & bar, and holds murder mystery dinners, musical events, karaoke, game nights, craft shows, painting classes... and you can rent it for your next event!
