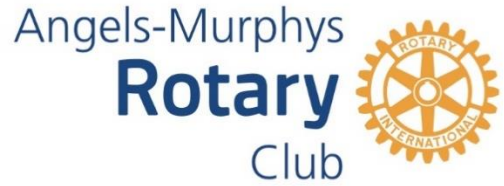

The 4 Way Test is on a roll, with Debbie as the latest new member to earn her blue badge! Sub Prez Mike reminded us about the privacy fence we built for the Children’s Advocacy Center, and got signups for staining it on Oct.12. Paula fined herself for not being able to go, and we all sang Happy Birthday to John.

Elizabeth Thompson and Kathi Toepel from Common Ground Senior Services returned to share more about Meals on Wheels, including 5 meals we got to sample! We presented our first \$7,000 donation which will feed 32 seniors an additional meal for a year. They described the “trickle down” financing that the program receives from the government and the major shortfall that leaves. Last



year they delivered 60,550 meals to 247 home bound people in two counties. The deliveries include a wellness check, and help increase socialization. We watched a very moving video of some recipients – all of whom mentioned relying on the loaf of bread. Funding is needed to get back up to 7 meals a week, and volunteers to assist on the Murphys/Arnold route are requested - even if just one day a month!



What we do!



Angels-Murphys Rotary Club holds great fundraisers so that we can do good in the community! We are proud that this small club can do so much in a year, such as:

- Award \$6000 in scholarships to graduating seniors
- Give winter coats, backpacks & school supplies to local children and illustrated dictionaries to every third grader in our district
- Purchase, pack and deliver holiday meals to 200 families
- Send Bret Harte juniors to leadership camp & honor outstanding students of all ages
- Replace wells and raise emergency funds for wildfire victims in California
- Construct park improvements, memorial benches and a community garden
- Foster the spirit of community service in our youth by mentoring Bret Harte’s Interact Club
- Support the Murphys Senior Center’s food pantry & Meals-on-Wheels
- Collect, repair and distribute wheelchairs for the disabled poor in the developing world
- Pack and ship 1750 pairs of shoes for repair and distribution by Soles4Souls
- Contribute to Rotary International’s Six Areas of Focus, including the worldwide eradication of polio
