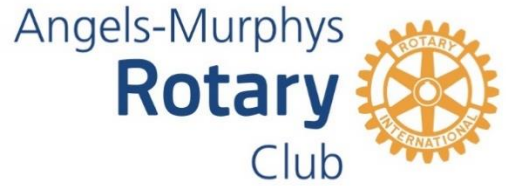

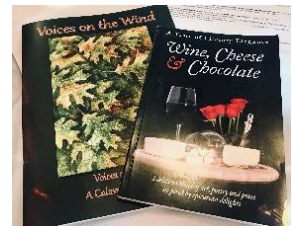
In case you missed it . . .
